



**MSF Statement**  
**Global Health Peace Initiative (GHPI)**  
**76<sup>th</sup> World Health Assembly – May 2023**

MSF acknowledges the work done to improve the road map on GHPI since the last EB.

However, while actions for peace are needed, they should not come at the cost of compromising medical neutrality, overloading healthcare workers or cause the de-prioritization of health. Uncertainty remains on how GHPI will be operationalized without bringing inadvertent negative repercussions to healthcare delivery.

We ask Member States and WHO Secretariat to avoid the unnecessary politicization of health, assess concretely the risks and impact of GHPI, and urge for health actors and affected communities to be properly consulted and heard.

As health actors delivering neutral and impartial medical assistance, we should focus on delivering on our professional obligation, i.e. medical care, health for health's sake.
